2023 Summer Update

We had an incredible summer of ministry at Kingswood Camp with a total of 471 camper registrations (including Family Camp) and 619 students attending spring programming.

Campers participated in canoeing, rocket building, outdoor skills, crafts, Chapel & Bible study, swimming, archery, axe throwing, rock climbing, zip line, campfires, and more. While unplugged from home campers embrace being a kid and grow in independence through fun adventures, building friendships, and spiritual formation

The staff team helped foster a community for campers to encounter Jesus Christ. Campers learn about who Jesus is, what he has done for them, and how to follow and live in relationship with him. This summer we saw campers receiving Bibles with joy and engaging eagerly in Bible study, both personal and group. There was a general openness and eagerness for prayer among campers and staff, and many impactful moments of prayer and worship were shared. We were privileged this summer to see a number of campers come to faith for the first time and numerous take further steps towards him. The friendships and community built at camp were quite special, with many moments of vulnerability and spiritual engagement

Our LIT program continues to show deep impact and growth in the teens that participate. These teens are take part in in-depth Bible studies, they are mentored spiritually and personally, and taught leadership principles while serving at camp in various capacities.
